TEACHING OBJECTIVES

- To identify and count from 1 to 99.
- To measure ingredients for making a cake.
- To follow instructions for making a cake.
- To use the vocabulary and structures necessary to buy the ingredients.

At the market

- To see that measuring is useful for cooking.

FINAL TASK

At the end of unit, pupils will bake a cake, following the recipe. They will measure ingredients previously purchased in the market.
